

About the move to Fleminghallen

In the autumn 2019, Fleminghallen in Flemingsbergsdalen will become a cultural and leisure centre. This decision was made by Kultur och fritidsnämnden on February 5 2019. Fleminghallen will become a venue where people can come together, generating and encouraging new ideas and new forms of expression – a meeting place that combines a library, youth activities, exhibition spaces and sporting opportunities in a modern facility.

Why are we moving these activities to Fleminghallen?

By bringing together the cultural and leisure facilities and activities all in one building, we are able to create a safer and more vibrant venue. The move represents a major step forward in the ongoing initiatives for organisational development.

What does the move involve?

Certain activities that are currently conducted elsewhere in Flemingsberg will be moving to Fleminghallen. These are the Panncentralen Ungzon and Ungzon Flemingsberg leisure-time centres and the Flemingsberg library. The move will mean that the library, youth leisure-time centers and sports organisations will work together more closely, as they will be sharing the same premises. There are no plans to reduce the quality or range of services. What the move does mean is that Fleminghallen will serve as a venue where everybody shall be made to feel welcome.

What will be available at Fleminghallen?

We are working to ensure open spaces, which create a welcoming environment. The building will be a venue where people come together, featuring:

- Physical activities/sports
- Library
- Youth activities
- Cultural activities and exhibition spaces
- Local associations and organisations
- Events
- Café

What is the timetable for the move?

The relocation of the various organisations and facilities are being planned to ensure there will be minimal impact on day-to-day operations. The physical act of moving, however, will mean that the library and leisure-time centres will either be temporarily closed or operate with limited functions for a short period until they are able to reopen in Fleminghallen. The reopening is planned to take place in conjunction with “En dag för Flemingsberg”, on Saturday 7 September 2019.

Flemingsberg library, Röntgenvägen 17: Closed from 3 June.

Panncentralen Ungzon leisure-time centre, Visättravägen 34: The building will be closed from 6 May, but there will be outdoor activities during the summer.

Ungzon Flemingsberg leisure-time centre, Röntgenvägen 15: The building will be closed from 6 May, but there will be outdoor activities during the summer.
